Attorney Grant Sovern (he/him) is a graduate of Tufts University and of Michigan Law School and has worked as an immigration lawyer for 30 years. He has also taught at the University of Wisconsin Law School, and he was one of the founding attorneys and Board President of the Community Immigration Law Center (CILC – pronounced “silk”). CILC is a public defender service for immigrants threatened with deportation in Wisconsin. CILC believes that everyone has a right to due process, which includes people accused of being deportable. He is presently CILC’s Administrative Director.

Rev. Breanna Illéné (she/her) is ordained in the United Methodist Church and has served in several congregations, including a Spanish speaking congregation. Presently she is the Director of Ecumenical Innovation and Justice Initiatives at the Wisconsin Council of Churches (WCC) where she leads the WCC’s advocacy work, resourcing churches to respond both at the state capitol and also in their local communities.
